The City Council of the City of Milford met in a Special Session in the Training Room of Milford City Hall at 201 South Walnut Street, Milford, Delaware, on Monday, December 19, 2022.

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Campbell called the meeting to order at 8:46 a.m. noting that all members were in attendance.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Councilmember Boyle moved to go into Executive Session reference the below statutes, seconded by Councilmember Baer:

Councilmember Fulton moved to return to Regular Session at 4:46 p.m., seconded by Councilmember James. Motion carried.

Police Chief Selection

Immediately following, Councilmember Boyle, moved to select Candidate #1 to fill the Police Chief vacancy, seconded by Councilmember Wilson. Motion carried by a roll call vote of 7-1, with Councilmember Fulton casting the sole dissenting vote.

ADJOURNMENT

Councilmember James moved to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Councilmember Culotta. Motion carried.
