Adoption of the ADA Self-Assessment & Transition Plan

Whereas, the City of Milford is required under Federal Law to comply with the standards of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, as amended by the ADA Amendments Act of 2008; and

Whereas, the City of Milford Department of Public Works is engendered with the work of maintaining and constructing public infrastructure within the City of Milford, including, but not limited to sidewalks, roadways, and parking lots and in carrying out such work becomes the arm of the City's ability to comply with the noted Act above; and

Whereas, the Department of Public Works has successfully conducted a Self-Assessment and produced an ADA Transition Plan and has properly noticed this document, inviting and considering public comment toward its final production for a period of no less than 60 days.
