

Irrigation Metering Guide

City of Milford – Resident Information

What is an Irrigation Meter?

A separate irrigation meter tracks **outdoor water use** (lawns, gardens, irrigation systems) apart from your household water and avoids sewer fees.

Installation Requirements

- Hire a **licensed plumber** to install the irrigation line & meter pit.
- Most neighborhoods do **not** have an irrigation meter pit already.
- A **City Inspector** will perform a backfill inspection and a meter pit inspection.

You'll Need:

- **Plot plan** showing irrigation line & meter pit location
- Reference: [City Standards & Specs](#)

Fees (per connection) FY26

- Irrigation Impact Fee: **\$3,738**
- Irrigation Meter Fee: **\$200**
- Backfill Inspection and Meter Install: **\$ 35**
- Permit Fee **\$10**
- **Total \$3,983**

Next Step

- Hire a licensed plumber
- Prepare your plot plan
- Apply for permit online
- Schedule required inspections
- Meter is set once inspections are complete
